## Protocol in case of a young saluki dying unexpectedly

In order to find out as much as possible about the condition, we need to know about individual deaths if we are to make sense of the statistics, and monitor progress and influence change to reduce or eliminate the number of deaths in the future. In the highly unlikely event that your young saluki does die suddenly of no apparent cause please follow the guidelines below.
