It was a long day for some of the dogs being second in the ring and then the Open show followed. I would also like to thank my steward Linda Aldous. A little disappointed in some exhibits having dirty teeth though the overall entry was good with some lovely quality dogs to go over, thank you all for supporting me and allowing me to judge your dogs and accepting my placings.

MPD (1) 1 Hudson's Mala's Amal Johari Dayim Mahatma Glenoak (Imp Deu) impressive 8.5 month youngster who shows promise for the future. Good body for one so young, dark eye correct ear leathers, moderate angulation, correct top line with gentle rise over the loin. Good depth of brisket. Once settled moved well for a youngster. Well up to size for his age. BPD RBPIS

PD (1) 1. Hudson's Mala's Amal Johari Dayim Mahatma Glenoak (Imp Deu)

JD (2) 1 Thomas Sincerity Kalimantan Cashar (Imp Fin) 13 month deer grizzle who is an excellent example of the breed, just oozes quality. Balanced throughout, once matured I think he will do really well. Nice head, correct eye with far seeing expression, good ear set, nice shoulder set. Correct top line with gentle rise over the loin. Well developed first and second thigh, good feet and gentle slope to pasterns, moved out well and was at one with his handler. 2. Harrison Zafaraniyeh Sahari 15 month Tri, a little unsettled when approached long narrow head with dark oval eye, deep chest, long straight forelegs. A little erratic on the move but given time should settle.

YD (1) 1. Thomas Sincerity Kalimantan Cashar (Imp Fin)

PGD (1) 1 Harrison Khamsin's Phoenix at Charrioak Tri smooth with a nice head and expression, dark eye, correct top line with gentle rise over the loin moved out well with his handler.

LD. 3 (1a) 1. De Souza, De Souza & Woodgate Luachmar Jalil black and tan with a very nice head, dark eyes, correct bite, strong neck leading to well laid shoulder, correct topline with slight rise over loin. Moderate bend of stifle with well developed first and second thigh. Would prefer a little more forechest infill. This boy just moved out better once handled by the other exhibitor, a true show of sportsmanship in this class. RBD 2. Phillips Luachmar Javan grizzle litter brother to first. Many of the same comments apply, shown in lovely condition, masculine head, good eye, correct topline nice tail set, moved out well covering

the ground with light lifting movement, preferred his front to first and was a very difficult decision between the 2 of them but lost out on balance of movement. OD (2) 1. De Souza De Souza & Woodgate Caryna Taivoa, gorgeous grizzle who I have always admired, has rather a strong head, good eye, correct ear set, good depth of chest. Covered the ground well with light lifting movement. Very sound and balanced. 2. Chippendale Flytesfield Hyddwn, a young dog and only lost out on maturity. Nice head good eye correct ear set, strong neck good shoulders straight forelegs. Fairly broad back with slight rise over the loin, well developed first and second thigh. Was enjoying himself too much today. VD (1) 1. Shaverneva & Rhodes very nice smooth who I remember seeing as a puppy. Not as big as other exhibits but all the same a nice boy. He has a very nice outline, nice head good oval eye with far seeing expression correct bite, good shoulder set. Correct topline and tail set. Well developed first and second thigh. Moved with reach and drive. BV & Best Smooth.

SBD (2) 1. Thomas Sincerity Kalimantan Cashar (Imp Fin) 2. Thomas Mumtaz Aramis a fawn with Irish Markings, nice head with correct eye, strong neck to well laid shoulder, correct top line with moderate rear, nice tail set he was a very happy boy running around the ring. CH D (3) CH Fernlark Legend of Cornhhaze JW did a lap of honour in this class due to the close friendship between myself and his owners. 1. Walton Haddon CH Badavie Don Peppino at Ilsham (Imp Swe) black and white parti long narrow head with large oval eye correct bite strong supple neck leading to well placed shoulder good depth of brisket, correct topline which he held on the move, nice tail set. Toes long and arched moved out soundly covering the ground with ease. BD & RBIS 2. Chippendale Int/Lux/Bel CH Imhotep Rears Natural Jasmine (Imp Bel) a cream boy with stronger head than first. Good eye, correct ear set, correct bite, long well muscled neck, straight forelegs with slight slope to pasterns, broad back with slight rise over loin, well developed first and second thigh , good feet, luxurious feathering, lost out to 1 today on movement.

PB (1) 1. Copperthwaite Alcaliphs Sahara Beyda 8 month cream bitch who has the most exquisite head, large dark oval eye with the most beautiful expression and the darkest pigmentation, she is ultra feminine throughout, nice shoulder with straight forelegs, slightly sloping pasterns, correct topline with gentle rise over the loin, correct tail set with moderate angulation, moved sound coming and going and was a joy to watch going round. I think she has a bright future. Was delighted to award her BPIS. JB. (2) (1a) 1. Davies Zafaraniyeh Dashte Margo 15 month Tri bitch of superb quality she certainly stands out in the ring. She has a beautiful outline and is moderate throughout with no exaggerations. Nice head, good eye, correct scissor bite, strong supple neck, good shoulders correct topline with rise over the loin, correct tail set. On the move she covered the ground effortlessly with good reach and drive and was at one with her handler. One to watch for the future. YB 2 (1a) 1. Davies Zafaraniyeh Dashte Kavir 15 month black fringed fawn litter sister

to junior. Very pretty bitch with a good head, nice eye, good ear set, correct bite, adequate neck to well placed shoulders, gentle slope to pasterns, correct feet, correct topline and gentle rise over the loin, nice tail set, moved well for her handler. PGB 2 (1a) 1. Copperthwaite Alcaliphs Belisama I've not seen this bitch out before but boy does she ooze quality. Excellent breed type. Looked lovely when stacked and certainly didn't disappoint on the move. Gorgeous cream with the most beautiful feminine head, darkest oval eye with good ear set, strong supple neck leading to excellent shoulder placement, correct straight forelegs with gentle slope to pasterns, deep brisket, nice tuck up, correct topline with gentle rise over the loin, in tip top condition, her movement was sound coming and going and she covered the ground with light lifting movement. Was delighted to award her BB & BIS. LB 4 (2a) 1. Corden & Atkinson Caryna Nadyenka for Gemgwynad, striking black/cream. Nice breed type. Good width of front with excellent infill of forechest. Correct layback of shoulder and return of upper arm. Perfect depth of chest with good underline cutting up to neat waist. In lovely condition and well handled. 2. Mackenzie Loughran Classicus Ophelia golden cream who is ultra feminine, she has a very pretty head with correct dark oval eye and ear set, deep brisket with nice tuck up. Very moderate in angulation, correct pasterns and hocks, good tail set, moved steadily with her handler. OB 3 (1a) 1 Phillips Luachmar Jamilah ShCEx a beautiful grizzle bitch of outstanding quality, litter sister to RBD. Loved her overall type, she is a picture stacked and certainly doesn't disappoint on the move. Good head, dark oval eye with far seeing expression strong supple neck leading to a good shoulder placement, lovely depth of brisket and good tuck up correct topline with gentle rise over the loin, correct tail set with well developed first and second thigh. Sound in all directions. It was lovely to watch her on the move being at one with her handler. RBB. 2. Ward Int/Lux/Bel CH Nicolefarhi Del Borghino (Imp Ita) another grizzle narrow head with dark oval eye well placed shoulder, straight forelegs with strong pasterns, correct topline with rise over the loin, nice tuck up. Excellent first and second thigh, she is a very fit bitch. A nice mover in all directions. Just unfortunate to come up against 1st today. VB 4 (2a) 1. Lewis Knight Ellington E-Isora a 7 year old cream bitch very much the old type saluki she had a nice head with dark eye, good ear set, correct bite, deep brisket, correct topline and tail set, moved steady with handler. 2. Woolmer Al Nafiseh Flowering Sage 7.5 year cream bitch who I've admired ringside, nice head and eye, correct bite good ear set, correct topline with gentle rise over the loin. Once settled moved well. SVB. 11. Davies Charrioak Sheerzam JW an 11 year old cream bitch who didn't like being out in the rain. Nice head with dark eye and correct ear set, correct bite, good depth of chest correct topline with gentle rise over the loin a very moderate bitch. Moved well with her handler. CHB 3 (2a). 1 Davies CH Classicus Alchemy for Charrioak JW a Tri quality moderate bitch with a very nice head, oval eye with wonderful expression. Strong supple neck, deep chest good tuck up straight forelegs with slightly sloping pasterns, correct

topline with gentle rise over the loin, correct tail set good first and second thigh. Moved well in all directions covering the ground with ease.

Brace 3 (1a) 1. Phillips, grizzle litter brother and sister who moved well together and was at one with their handler, looked lovely together. 2. Davies black and tan both sound movers but felt 1st were more in sync.
